What Goes Where

Recycling

Make sure recyclables are loose, clean and dry before placing in the cart!

Metal and Glass

- Aluminum Cans
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Tin Cans (Canned Vegetables and Soup)
- Steel Cans
- Glass Bottles (Wine, Liquor, Juice)
- Glass Food Jars (Condiments)



Paper

- Newspaper
- Paper
- Cardboard
- Paper Envelopes
- Junk Mail
- Magazines/Catalogs
- Phone Books
- Paper Bags
- Non-Metallic Wrapping Paper



Plastics #1-7



- Plastic Bottles (Water, Juice, Soda)
- Plastic Jugs (Milk and Juice)
- Plastic Jars (Condiments)



What Goes Where

Trash

The trash cart is for waste that cannot be recycled.

- Polystyrene Foam (Styrofoam Containers and Packaging)
- Non-Recyclable Plastics
- Plastic Utensils
- Wax-Coated Paper Cups
- Pet Waste/Diapers
- Garden Hoses
- Non-Donatable Clothing, Bedding and Textiles



Do not place needles, chemicals, paint, fluorescent light bulbs, propane tanks, full or partially full aerosol containers, batteries and electronics, and/or construction debris inside any of your containers.

Other Recycling and Diversion Programs

Bulky Item Collection for Residents with container service

- Bulky items include large, hard-to-handle items such as furniture, appliances, and electronic waste.
- Irvine residents with toter service may schedule four free bulky item collections with up to four items per pickup per year for free.
- Schedule with Waste Management Customer Service at least 48 hours in advance of your collection day.



Safely Dispose of Household Hazardous Waste


County of Orange Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off Program

- Universal, hazardous and electronic waste products are products that are flammable, corrosive, reactive, or toxic. These products can be dangerous to the public and the environment.
- This waste must be disposed of properly, and it is illegal to dispose of hazardous, universal, or electronic waste in your Waste Management containers.
- Orange County residents can dispose of household hazardous waste safely, and for free, at any of the four locations below:
 - Irvine 6411 Oak Canyon • Irvine
 - Anaheim 1071 N. Blue Gum Street • Anaheim
 - Huntington Beach 17121 Nichols Street - Gate 6 • Huntington Beach
 - San Juan Capistrano 32250 La Pata Ave. • San Juan Capistrano

Disability Walk-Up Service

- Qualifying customers are eligible to receive valet service.
- Residents must provide a DMV issued placard/paperwork
- Physician letter confirming customer is unable to move carts and there is no other capable person living at the home to assist
- Application filled out with Release of Liability attached
- Please keep in mind the application is good for one year
